

ABOUT IFHNOS

Dr. Jatin P. Shah proposed the establishment of an international organization to bring together all specialists involved in the care of patients with Head and Neck Cancer, in 1985. The proposal was enthusiastically received by the Society of Head and Neck Surgeons, and leaders of Head and Neck Oncologic Societies worldwide were contacted to explore the feasibility of establishing the International Federation of Head and Neck Oncologic Societies. A steering committee was formed, which drafted the constitution and bylaws of the Federation, in 1987. Dr. Jatin Shah was elected Secretary General by unanimous vote of the Governing Council. The initial programs of the Federation consisted of expanding membership, compilation of a newsletter, and organizing World Congresses. Over the years, the Federation has grown with a membership of 70 Head and Neck oncologic organizations, representing 58 countries. The Federation has successfully attained its initial goal and mission of establishing channels of communication to foster camaraderie amongst professionals involved in the care of patients with head and neck cancer.





HEAD AND NECK CANCER SUMMIT

IFHNOS has introduced a new program starting 2024 called the "Head and Neck Cancer Summit," which will be a comprehensive three-day program covering the entire field of Head and Neck surgery and oncology. **The First Summit will be in Chennai**, India, held from Feb. 15-18, 2024, developed in collaboration with the Department of Head and Neck Surgery and Oncology of Memorial Sloan Kettering Cancer Center (MSKCC) and its center in Chennai, MSK India. The faculty will consist of members of the multidisciplinary Head and Neck team of MSKCC and leaders in the specialty from India and neighboring nations.

The second summit is planned for South America, and will be held in Sao Paulo, Brazil in the fall of 2024.



GLOBAL ON LINE FELLOWSHIP

The Global On Line Fellowship program developed by IFHNOS in collaboration with Memorial Sloan Kettering Cancer Center (MSKCC) in New York aims to establish a standard of knowledge and amongst head and neck surgeons in the care of patients with neoplasms in the Head and Neck. It is a 2 year self-learning program with periodic on line written examinations followed by an oral examination before an International panel of examiners. The program also requires a one month period of "Observership" at one of the approved centers of excellence around the world shown in the table below. . Upon successful completion the candidate is awarded a certificate, which indicates that the candidate has acquired a globally established standard of core knowledge and matured judgment.



INTERNATIONAL FELLOWSHIP IN HEAD AND NECK SURGERY (IFHNS)

IFHNOS introduced a new program called the "Comprehensive International Fellowship in Head and Neck Surgery and Oncology" (IFHNS) in 2021. This Fellowship program emphasizes hands on surgical training in an accredited international training center. This program also requires that the candidate complete either concurrently or in tandem the Global On Line Fellowship (GOLF) academic program to acquire theoretical knowledge and judgment. Candidates who complete both the clinical and the academic requirements of these programs, will be eligible for conferral of the title of IFHNS (International Fellow in Head and Neck Surgery). The Directors of the approved programs are established leaders in the specialty, and the centers offering this comprehensive Fellowship program have met with international standards of head and neck training and are accredited by IFHNOS.
